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Dear Senator Blakespear and other members of the California State Legislature,

I strongly oppose the LOSSAN Working Group's recommendation to exempt railroad related activities and infrastructure from CEQA environmental reviews (Recommendation 4.1(3)). The railroad traverses many miles of ecologically sensitive areas in California, including the LOSSAN corridor and the 1.7 mile stretch on the geologically sensitive Del Mar Bluff. It is of utmost importance that these sensitive areas go through a CEQA review before any changes, such as double tracking or added infrastructure, take place.

Please reject this recommendation from the Working Group as it would undermine local control and protection of California's ecologically sensitive areas.
